Clutha Agricultural Development Board (CADB) Telford Scholarship

Terms & Conditions of the Scholarship

1. The Clutha Agricultural Development Board (CADB) Telford Scholarship was established in 2023. The Scholarship is for a student studying at the Te Pukenga - Southern Institute of Technology – Telford Campus. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a student that has enrolled in a full year course from Telford and whose home is within the Clutha District Council area.
2. The purpose of the Scholarship is to encourage and support students whose home is within the Clutha District Council area to attend the Southern Institute of Technology – Telford Campus.
3. A Scholarship for the amount of up to \$2,500.00 may be awarded. Payment of the Scholarship shall be 50% on commencement of study and 50% on successful completion of a full year of study.
4. The recipient shall be selected on the basis of:
 - Enrolled on one of the following full year courses:
 - Diploma in Agriculture
 - NZ Certificate in Animal Technology (Rural Animal Technician)
 - Farming Systems and Equipment
 - Or an equivalent full-time, NZQA approved programme offered at the Telford campus
 - Financial circumstances.
 - Results or marks gained in an examination or assignment.
 - Personality and character.
5. The applicant should outline in their application the involvement and contribution they wish to make in the future to the agricultural industries of New Zealand.
6. The recipient will be selected by representatives of Clutha Foundation.
7. The decision of the granting of the Scholarship shall be final and no appeal or reconsideration will be entered into.
8. The applicants will be required to attend a short interview.
9. The Clutha Foundation may refrain from making an award if it finds no applicants of sufficient merit.
10. The Clutha Foundation reserves the right to publicly announce the results of the Scholarship awarded.
11. The Clutha Foundation may ask for the first instalment of the Scholarship to be refunded if the student does not complete the full year of study.
